

HOME ECONOMICS AND AG PRODUCTS RULES

DUE TO STATE REQUIREMENTS, A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER WILL BE REQUIRED FOR ALL EXHIBITORS PRIOR TO ENTRY.

1. All entries must be entered between 3:00pm and 8:00pm on Friday, July 30, 2010.
2. Each exhibitor will be required to purchase an exhibitor pass at \$6.00. (\$2.00 for exhibitors 12 and under)
3. **Entry fees will be paid by winners only. Entry fees will not be deducted from the premium check. Winners must pay the entry fee by a check or cash before they will receive the premium check.**
4. All exhibits must be complete.
5. Exhibitors may enter as many classes as desired, but only one entry per class.
6. No article that has ever won a prize at a previous Georgetown Fair may be exhibited for a prize, but will be welcome for display.
7. Professionals may not compete for awards but may exhibit for display only.
8. Every precaution will be taken to insure safety for all against loss or damage to articles, but in no case will management be liable for same.
9. Judges' decisions will be final in all cases.
10. Exhibits may be removed between 9:00 am and 1:00 pm on Saturday, August 7, 2010. Early release will NOT be allowed except under conditions of extreme hardship and only then at the discretion of the Fair President or Secretary. PLEASE, do not ask for early release. After release, **FAIR ASSN. WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR REMAINING ENTRIES.**
11. Overall Grand Champion Rosette will be awarded to outstanding entry in each department.
12. The Junior Departments are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in third grade and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair.
13. If there are fewer entries than premiums, ie 5 places paid and only 3 entries, the entries **must** be awarded the highest premiums.

Specific Departmental Rules

Floriculture - Dept. L

1. NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS
2. Exhibitor must attach name of plant.

Fine Arts - Dept. M

1. ALL WORK MUST BE ORIGINAL. NO COPIES.
2. Name and address of owner must appear on the back of each print or exhibit entered.
3. **ALL EXHIBITS MUST BE FRAMED AND READY TO HANG. NO TAPE, STRING, OR METAL PICTURE HANGERS; WIRE MUST BE ON BACK FOR HANGING.**
4. Maximum height and/or length of each entry cannot exceed 36 inches.

Textiles - Dept. M1

1. All exhibits must be shown in the name of the person who made the article.
2. All exhibits must have been made since 2009 and not previously entered in the Georgetown Fair.
3. All exhibits are to be suitable for showing and freshly laundered.

Education & Natural History - Dept. N

1. Exhibit must be entered under name of one who has made or collected exhibit.
2. The Junior Departments classes are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in third grade and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair.
3. School exhibits must have been made since August, 2009.
4. No exhibit will be accepted if larger than 18" x 24" x 12", exceptions for science entries - tri-fold boards will be accepted.
5. All exhibits must be secured properly and covered.
6. All art work must be matted or framed properly and be secured with a proper hanger and not larger than 24" x 30". All art work will be hung if possible.

Culinary - Dept. O

1. All baked goods must be on disposable plates.
2. There must be at least 3 pieces of candy on a plate.
3. There must be at least 3 cookies on a plate.
4. All canned fruit and vegetables must be canned in 2009 and 2010. Canning jars must have rings on them.

5. Jellies must be in jelly glasses with tight fitting lids.
6. No pies that require refrigeration will be allowed.

Junior - Dept. P

1. The Junior Departments are open to boys and girls who are 8 years of age or in third grade and not yet 19 years of age on or before September 1 of the year previous to the fair.
2. All products must be the work of the exhibitor **and must have been made since August, 2009 and not previously entered in the Georgetown Fair.**
3. All baked goods must be placed on **small white** disposable plates.
4. There must be at least three cookies per plate and must be baked.
5. There must be at least three pieces of candy per plate.
6. All canned fruits and vegetables must be canned in 2009 and 2010
7. Jellies must be in jelly glasses and covered with a lid.

Miscellaneous - Dept. V - Collections and JuniorHobby

1. Only collections that cannot be entered in Educational and Natural History Department can be entered.
2. No exhibit will be accepted if larger than 18" x 24" x 12" with the exception of Lego exhibitions will be limited to no larger than 12" x 12" x 12".
3. Exhibit must be the work of the exhibitor.
4. The Junior Departments are open boys/girls who are 8 years of age, or who will be entering the 3rd grade for the 2010-2011 school year and who will not reach their 19th birthday before the start of the fair.
5. Collections must be brought in a display of any sort (box, basket, etc.)

Miscellaneous - Dept. V - Antiques

1. All exhibits must be 50 years and older
2. Professionals and Dealers are asked to "Display Only"

Miscellaneous - Dept. V - Adult Hobby

1. All items must have been completed since January 1, 2008.
2. Professionals and Dealers are asked to "Display Only"

Kids Korner - Dept. KK

1. Any boy or girl who is not 8 years old by January 1, 2010 and younger.
