

## NOTE TO BREEDERS

The Georgetown Fair Association has made every effort to provide a purebred show for every breed. It is the responsibility of the purebred breeders representing a specific breed to provide sufficient numbers of animals to make it economically feasible to show each breed as a separate unit. The Georgetown Fair Livestock Committee prefers to show each breed as a separate show. However, this committee reserves the right to move any breed not presenting adequate numbers of animals for a representative "breed show" into an "all other breed" competition. This decision, when made, is final and is made totally at the discretion of the Georgetown Fair Livestock Committee.

At the discretion of the livestock committee, a breed not designated to be shown as a separate breed, may be removed from A.O.B. classification and shown in its own breed show, if animal numbers exists.

The Code of Ethics for Livestock Exhibition will be enforced. It is strictly prohibited to use any foreign substance in preparing any animal for the show ring.

Notice: It is mandatory for all out of state livestock to provide a "Permit to Enter" certificate provided by the Illinois Dept. of Agriculture before exhibition in the State of Illinois. (Call 217-782-4944 for details.)

## OPEN STEER SHOW RULES

1. Crossbred heifers and steers will be weighed on Sunday, August 5, 2018 at 7:00pm
2. Steers will be shown by breed.
3. The number of classes of steers shown in a breed will be determined by breed numbers and individual steer weights. Decisions as to breed classes will be made by the livestock committee.
4. Any breed which has less than 3 steers will be shown in AOB. -Crossbred competition.
5. There will be a max. of 12 classes of individual steers shown.
6. There will be one "Pair of Steers" class and all breeds will show together.
7. The calf scramble calves only will show in the calf scramble class. Scramble calves are eligible for other steer show classes.
8. Crossbred steers and AOB steers will be shown together.

### SPECIAL NOTES

- A. Steers will be weighed and placed in the breed class as designated by the steer's owner. The Georgetown Fair livestock committee reserves the right to request proof of a steer's breeding if shown as a purebred steer. Proof of breeding will be confirmed by a purebred steer certificate issued by the breed association in which the animal's sire and dam are recorded.
- B. If an official protest is lodged against a steer's eligibility to show in a purebred show, this procedure will be followed:
  1. Protestor will produce \$25 cash to the fair secretary and submit the protest in writing, signed by the protestor.
  2. This \$25 is forfeited to the Georgetown Fair Association if the protest is not sustained.
  3. The burden of proof of the breeding of any protested steer or steers rests with the steer's owner. Proof will be substantiated by presentation to the livestock superintendent of a purebred steer certificate issued to the steer owner by the purebred association in which the steer's sire and dam are recorded.
- C. All steers must be calved after Jan. 1, 2017.
- D. A \$25 Gift Certificate will be awarded to the Exhibitor of Each Breed Champion Steer.

The calves caught in 2018 will be shown in a special Calf Scramble Steer Class. Trophies will be awarded to the calf scramble calves for the following:

- Calf with best beef conformation
- Calf with highest average daily gain
  - Best groomed calf
- Highest Selling Scramble Calf
  - Champion Scrapbook

Calf scramble calves are eligible for the Open Steer Show.

**RULES OF 2018 CALF SCRAMBLE**

1. Junior age exhibitors, 10 years and older are eligible for the scramble. Participation in scramble for kids under 10 years of age will be considered at the request of the parents involved.
2. The Georgetown Fair will provide 8 calves for the scramble.
3. A check for the purchase price of the calf will be paid to the Georgetown Fair by the buyer, at the auction. Original purchase of the calf will be deducted and a check for the balance will be sent to the owner within 5 days of sale.
4. Participants catching calves must purchase mortality insurance at their expense. Source of this insurance will be specified by the Georgetown Fair.
5. Each calf will be weighed as requested by the fair committee and a report of this weighing sent to the Calf Scramble Chairman of the Georgetown Fair.
6. Calf Scramble calves caught in 2018 must be exhibited at the 2019 Georgetown Fair.
7. All calves caught in the 2018 calf scramble must be sold in the 2019 Georgetown Fair Junior Livestock Auction.
8. The Georgetown Fair Association is not responsible for accidents in the calf scramble.
9. The owner assumes responsibility for all expenses for his calf for the duration of the feeding period.
10. A committee of the Georgetown Fair will make the final decisions on the replacement of any calves caught in the 2018 Calf Scramble.
11. Calf Scramble applications are available from Section 18 Ag Teachers, and in the Georgetown Fair Livestock Office.
12. Transfer of ownership of a calf from the individual catching the calf to a different individual must be approved by the Georgetown Fair Calf Scramble Committee, and will be approved only if an absolute valid reason for said transfer exists.
13. The Georgetown Fair reserves the right to remove a scramble calf from a participant if it becomes obvious the calf is not being properly cared for.
14. The Georgetown Fair Association calf scramble is not affiliated with nor sponsored by any feed company.
15. Successful 2018 calf scramble participants are expected to exhibit their calves at the 2019 Georgetown Fair Beef Preview Show, held on the last Sunday of June, 2019.

### **SPECIFIC RULES FOR ACTUAL CONTEST**

1. Because of the possibility of serious injury during the contest, the 2018 contestants will scramble for 50 - 60# pigs. Calves will be on the grounds for inspection by scramble contestants during the day on Wednesday, August 8, 2018. Successful scramblers will select their choice of the scramble calves in the order in which the pigs are caught.
2. Only one participant will be permitted to handle a pig at any time. A pig which is loose is fair game for all contestants.
3. A committee will be designated immediately prior to contest to conduct the scramble. Any controversy arising during the contest will be ruled upon by this committee immediately, and the decision of the committee will be considered absolutely final.
4. A designated official will be assigned to each pig throughout the contest. This person will make all decisions pertaining to that specific pig and the committee in conjunction with the designated official for any pig in question will render an immediate and final decision on any controversy which might occur.
5. The Calf Scramble Committee will consist of representatives of the Georgetown Fair Association.
6. All participants and their parents or guardians will sign a waiver of responsibility and liability releasing the Georgetown Fair Association from all liability.
7. Calves used for the 2018 Calf Scramble will be assembled one week before the fair date and held together to be clamped, wormed, implanted, vaccinated, weighed and started on feed during this time period. Successful calf scramble participants may take their calf at the completion of showing or no later than Saturday, August 11, 2018, before noon.
8. Calf owners will pay a subtotal fee to cover health charges, feed charges and mortality insurance when they pick up their calf. Calf owners may pay only this subtotal fee at pickup and defer the original cost of the calf until after the calf is sold in the 2019 Junior Livestock Auction. Interest rate to be determined and will be stated on the 2018 scramble contract for any unpaid balances.
9. Each successful calf scramble participant will keep a detailed scrap book on their calf. These scrap books will be judged and a Award will be presented to the exhibitor with the Champion scrap book.
